Primary Responsibilities:

- Track development activity by entering donor interactions and strategies into COCI's

- fundraising database
- Work closely with the COCI Development team to develop and successfully execute strategies that will increase the number of major donors, increase gifts year to year, and achieve annual goals
- Create ways to link donors' interests with COCI programs and volunteer opportunities
- Create presentations in order to build cases for support
- Recruit and steward major donors through engagement activities
- Perform other related duties and participate in special projects as assigned by the Senior VP of Development
